**Note:** Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered for an award.

Top applicants will be selected by the GPA Scholarship Committee to be interviewed by the GPA Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will then award three one-time scholarships based on the application, interview, and other predetermined criteria. The scholarship amounts will be as follows:

<b>1st - \$3,000</b>
<b>2nd - \$1,000</b>
<b>2nd - \$1,000</b>

GPA will announce the scholarship recipients at the Green High School Senior Awards Night on May 22, 2018.
